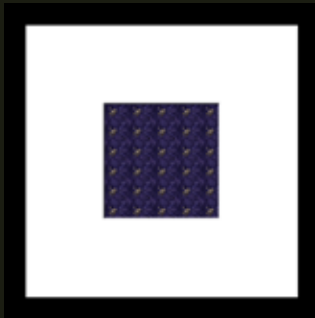

Please take your time when browsing through our brochure. You'll love what The Julie Anne Collection has to offer to your home, office or place of comfort.

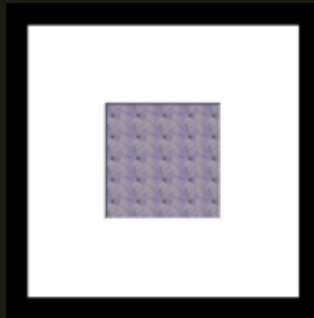

Award Winning Floral Artists

...creates unique contemporary fine art from blooms of exceptional quality, framed and preserved for viewing pleasure.

To create these unique floral compositions, Julie Anne utilizes only the largest and most colorful varieties, harvested at the very peak of freshness, from some of the leading growers in the world.

In order to dry them at the height of color, the blooms are placed in a special solution to preserve their unique perfection. Then, each individual flower, free of stem, is transferred to a press and placed in a flash-dry processor that allows the blooms to dry at a rate that conserves the beautiful color.

Once the preservation process is complete, Julie Anne begins her inimitable handiwork, utilizing the very best of the blooms as her medium: applying the flowers in a creative technique she devised in 1985. Each floral confection is built on a special dehydrator backing in order to preserve the blossoms' colors.

Matted and framed behind glass, Julie Ann's floral master pieces demonstrates her love and passion for flowers.

A student of floral art since 1974, and a recipient of numerous awards, Julie Anne's unique professional skills were professionally recognized in 1989 when she was inducted into the pre-eminent company of the most distinguished association of Floral Artists in the U.S., the American Institute of Floral Designers.

By purchasing one of Julie Anne's incomparable original works of art, you are acquiring an artifact of exceptional quality - a matchless floral mosaic, hand-signed by the artist.

Julie Anne & Jim Gibson were both born in the flower business. At their studio situated in the beautiful San Tan Mountains of Queen Creek, Arizona, they are inspired by their surroundings and spend the days creating new designs and collecting many natural desert materials to work with.

Jim has been a student of Floral Art since 1972. Jim aspired to paint from a very early age because of his intense interest in nature and wildlife. At the age of 10 he began regular tutelage with his father as his mentor a skilled artist in his own right. Jim paints in acrylics and has mastered several other mediums, he has applied his keen eye for painting to his floral confections inspired by his wife Julie Anne.

Jim and Julie Anne have been pressing flowers for the past 15 years and have come up with an original concept. They have applied their knowledge to an age old medium of pressed flowers, taking it to the next level and demonstrating that they are real trend setters, a dynamic duo, with a love and passion for flowers.

Frequently Asked Questions

The JulieAnne COLLECTION by The James Company

Q. What are your prices?

A. Please call one of our galleries for a quote on a retail price.

Q. Can I buy from you directly?

A. No, we don't compete with our dealers. We're happy to answer questions, though!

Q. I saw your work on vacation, but there's no gallery near me. How can I order?

A. If you know the size of the piece, and the pattern you want (check our website for those), you can usually order by phone through any gallery using a credit card - ask to have the piece shipped directly to you.

Q. How long will it take to get my piece? Will it arrive assembled?

A. We have a very structured schedule and will quote a "shipdate" when you place your order. It's usually 6-8 weeks, depending on the season. Most pieces ship via UPS. All wall art comes assembled. Furniture ships disassembled. We include screws and simple instructions for attaching table tops to their bases.

Q. Do you sell to interior designers?

A. Yes - we require a resale certificate AND one of the following: membership in a professional design association; a commercial address for interior design; or a commercial listing in the yellow pages specifically for interior design. We also have a minimum opening order. Email julieg2u@hotmail.com for more information.

Q. Can I get a different size of table or mirror than what you have shown?

A. Yes! Give the gallery or designer the dimensions you need for a quote. Our height options are limited to the leg and base heights we offer, but special size table tops, mirrors and wall art are no problem.

Q. Do you offer different table legs or bases than what you have shown?

A. Yes, iron legs and wood legs. You are welcome to purchase a table top only and supply your own base.

Q. How accurate are the colors shown on your website?

A. They are close, but all flowers & leaves vary in color.

Q. Can I make changes to colors or patterns?

A. Yes, please ask for a custom design.

Q. I'm not sure what I want. Can Julie make suggestions?

A. Yes.

Q. How long do they last & do they keep their color?

A. The flowers & leaves are completely sealed and airtight so no air or moisture can get to them - moisture in the air is what takes the color from a flower or leaf. We use a special process and a dehydrator.

Q. Will they fade or crumble?

A. They will fade from direct sunlight, or strong U.V. light. The flowers will never disintegrate because of the sealing process.
